Expected Graduation: December 2022

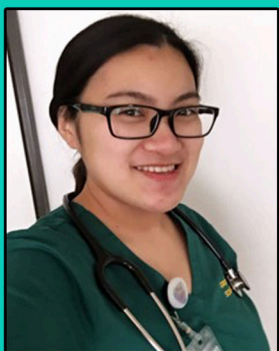
